## B. Automobile Appraisals

Tom Simatos gave a presentation at one of our club meetings last year. Here is some information from him if you are interested in having an appraisal done.

### AUTOMOBILE APPRAISALS COLLECTIBLE AND CONTEMPORARY VEHICLES

Many times I have been asked to briefly identify what to look for in an appraisal, be it a collectible or a contemporary vehicle. There are many things to consider when having an appraisal done for your vehicle. Probably the most important consideration is the purpose of the appraisal. Most common considerations include determining insurance coverage needs, an insurance claim settlement, or determining market value when buying or selling a vehicle. Other considerations include estate issues, charitable donation, and collateral for loan considerations. The list can be endless but whatever the need for an appraisal, the document should include two key elements:

1. The purpose- what is the reason for the appraisal, and
2. The intended use -who will receive the appraisal.

After the purpose and intended use are determined there are other items that should be included as part of the appraisal process and in the written document. They include:

- ③ Vehicle data and equipment
- ③ Witness condition of the vehicle by the appraiser (unless the vehicle is not available, i.e., stolen, fire loss, etc.)
- ③ Definitions/methodology-appropriate explanations so the reader understands
- ③ Documentation of the subject vehicle with comparables in the most relevant market
- ③ A specific value conclusion
- ③ Signed certification- denoting the appraiser has no interest in the vehicle or if there is an interest, it is so noted

Finally, as with any formal document it should be signed and dated by the appraiser with an effective date of the valuation. Also, appropriate documentation of sources used be included and a brief summary of the appraiser's credentials.

Please note there are many approaches in the appraisal process. This briefly identifies the key elements.

## D.No Collector Car Left Behind

Jack Tokie and Dorothy Maseles were invited by Hagerty Insurance to go to the Capitol building in Lansing on September 27, 2005 and show Jack's car in support of the "No Collector Car Left Behind" legislation to change the restrictions on use of and fees for historical license plates. Terri Lynn Land, the Michigan Secretary of State, spoke as well as a couple of state representatives. It was a very nice function - there are some pictures below of Terri Lynn Land with Jack Tokie, and Governor Jennifer Granholm in Jack's '56. MCR members Ed & Sue Pashukewich were there with their -----, and several members of the REO Olds Chapter, including Don and Eva Cooper, attended as well. There was an article written with a picture in Old Cars Weekly - October 13<sup>th</sup> issue.

The legislation being introduced offers Michigan collector car owners reasonable registration categories (for insurance purposes) and fair registration fees based on limited usage and the ability to drive a collector car for occasional pleasure. Collector car owners could realize a savings of \$1,000 over a five year period with this legislation.

The bill was proposed by the Hagerty Collector Network - House Bill 4362. The purpose of Hagerty's inaugural Collector Car Appreciation Day was to encourage other states to pass similar legislation for fair registration practices of collector cars. **Spot Availability:**

Because of the additional demand for spots again this year the MCR officers and some members made the following decisions. We do want to be as fair as possible to all.

First priority will be given to MCR/OCA members as again this year we will be covered with insurance by the OCA. We will be working out the details to again have an OCA Road show booth/table to promote OCA and the Motor City Rockets. OCA also provides funds to the club for Road Show events/flyers etc.
